Key Nutrients You Can't Skip

Let's take a closer look at the essential bariatric vitamins and why they matter:

Iron: Often lost during menstruation or low-calorie intake, iron is key for energy. Choose bariatric vitamins

with iron to avoid dizziness and weakness.

Vitamin B12: Post-surgery, your stomach may not produce enough intrinsic factor to absorb B12. Sublingual

tablets or sprays work best.

Calcium & Vitamin D3: Calcium citrate is preferred over carbonate, and should be taken separately from iron.

Folate (Folic Acid): Especially important for women of childbearing age and overall cellular repair.

Zinc: Supports immune system recovery and wound healing after surgery.
